

Amongst the big changes afoot at the Arts Centre are a positive shift in the film programme mix with the addition of a hand-picked selection of 'First Run' features - so see the very best new films as they come out from the day they come out - a subtle but significant shift for Canterbury's Independent Cinema.

And many major events across our year in music: from the rare chance to hear the **Complete Shostakovich** string quartet cycle performed by the wonderful **Brodsky Quartet** (10-12 Oct) to a full-on star-studded **Medway Takeover** celebrating the Medway Sound curated by the great **James Taylor**. (21 & 22 Nov)

And in the second half of the year look-out for our amazing new festival **'You Are Here'** - a historic gathering of many of the finest independent music presenters and producers festivals and venues from across Kent working together to create a weekend of extraordinary range and adventurous listening. (27 Feb - 1 Mar)

And there's barely space to mention the best comedy series in Kent, the finest folk series money can buy from Folk in the Barn and the finest classical series in the county from Canterbury Music Club, the very best family series for miles around....not to mention the campest Christmas in Canterbury.

'Boat To Bolivia' was the debut album by Martin Stephenson & The Daintees.

After appearances on Channel 4's 'The Tube' and BBC2's 'Whistle Test' the album went on to become one of the essential releases of 1986, with The Observer declaring that 'Boat To Bolivia' was "...the most striking debut since Dexys Midnight Runners".

Martin Stephenson & The Daintees will be performing the 'Boat To Bolivia' album in full and in sequence along with other favourites from their extensive career.

#### Paul Booth's love of the iconic Beach Boys album Pet Sounds led him to transcribe the original album in its entirety, and then arrange it for his Big Band 'Bansangu', with sell out shows at Ronnie Scott's in 2024. This year Pet Sounds Reimagined has expanded to include the Festival Chamber Orchestra, exploring the music of the Beach Boys in yet more exciting and innovative ways.

Alongside this 'Bird with Strings' uses the wonderfully lush orchestral arrangements which feature on the album 'Charlie Parker with Strings' which he recorded in the late 1940's and early 50's.

Both albums are seen as classics in their own right and the new versions performed this evening, present a wonderful fusion of Classical and Jazz with a wonderful tapestry of musical styles and colours.

# Music

#### Department

Based at the award-winning Colyer-Fergusson Hall on the Canterbury campus, our Extra-Curricular Music Department presents a vibrant programme of music-making, open to all students and staff at the University, and to the local community, throughout the academic year. From orchestral works to big band swing, choral concerts, Musical Theatre, chamber opera and more, from our outstanding concert-hall to Canterbury Cathedral and Deal Memorial Bandstand, there are plenty of opportunities to rehearse and perform, whatever you study.

Music Performance Scholarships are also open to talented instrumentalists and singers, offering a cash bursary and the opportunity to continue with instrumental or singing lessons, as part of being involved in University musical life. Practice-rooms are available for use throughout the year, including a dedicated band-room for amplified instruments.
