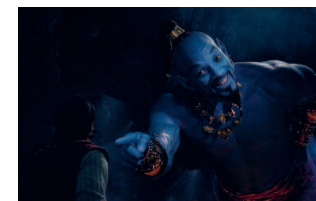
## 50 Years Festival
